The Michigan Rural Water Association would like to extend an excellent opportunity for your students to express their ideas, gain insight into the importance of water conservation and a clean water supply and possibly win cash prizes for themselves and your school.

MRWA is sponsoring a video contest for Michigan High School Students. The goal is to create public awareness on the topics of Water Conservation or Watershed Protection. Each team is encouraged to include their local water and/or wastewater utility in their video if that is possible at this time. Each team must have a sponsoring teacher and while any teacher can serve as a sponsor, this is ideal for those who work with environmental science, media technology or communications. There is a 10 video limit per school. Sponsoring teachers should coordinate and select their top 10 videos for submission.

There is a Grand Prize of \$1,500.00 to be awarded to the sponsoring teacher/department as well as \$250.00 gift card to each student of the winning team. There is a limit of four students per team.

The winner will be notified by March 4, 2022 and will be invited to attend MRWA's Annual Management and Technical Conference to receive their prizes.

- Open to 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students in any accredited high school in Michigan
- Each video must be sponsored by a school teacher
- Create a video up to 45 seconds ---- on your own or as a team
- Limit of four students per team
- LIMIT OF 10 VIDEOS PER SCHOOL
- Contest Themes

Water Conservation

Watershed Protection

- Teams are encouraged to include local water and/or wastewater utilities in the video if possible.
- \$1,500 will be awarded to the school which can be used for equipment etc.
- Gift Cards in the amount of \$250 will be given to each winning team member.
- End your video with the MRWA logo. Found on the MRWA website.
- At either the beginning or end of the video, you must include the school name and the FIRST name only of each student who worked on the video. This introduction or ending does not count toward the 45 second limit.
- Your video must be received no later than January 14, 2022
- You may upload the video to your youtube, instragram or other online account and email the link and forms to membersvcs@mrwa.net.
- YOU MUST send the video link and forms on the same email.
- Please send each video on a separate email and in the subject line include the school and team name or video number

ie: Smithville School Video 1 or Smithville School Team Jane. Something to make each email unique so they are easily searched on.

# Michigan Rural Water Association Video Contest Official Rules

**The Challenge** – Create a video up to 45 seconds long based on one of the following themes. (1) Water Conservation or (2) Watershed Protection. At either the beginning or end of the video, you must include the school name and the FIRST NAME ONLY of each student who worked on the video. This introduction or ending does not count toward the 45 second limit.

Who's Eligible – The contest is open to students in Michigan in grades 9 - 12, individually or as a group entry of no more than **four** students. An individual teacher representing a specific department within your school must sponsor entries. **LIMIT OF 10 VIDEOS PER SCHOOL.** 

The Sponsoring Teacher – The sponsor's role is to encourage students' participation and provide general guidance in how to plan a video and enter the contest – not developing the creative concept or executing the video. Any teacher can serve as the sponsor, but this is ideal for those who work with environmental science, media technology, English or communications. If a science teacher wants to work with media technologies teacher to co-sponsor, that's great – they just need to split the \$1,500 award if their student(s) win the contest.

The Timeframe – Michigan Rural Water Association must receive submitted videos by January 14, 2022

**The Awards** – The winning entry will receive: \$1,500 paid directly to the school's sponsoring teacher/department and a \$250 gift card to each student team member. (Limit of 4 students per video)

**The Fame** – Winning entry will be showcased online at <a href="www.mrwa.net">www.mrwa.net</a> and at the MRWA Management & Technical Conference in March 2022. Winning students and sponsoring teachers will be invited to attend the MRWA Conference for an awards event.

**Judging** – MRWA Conference and Awards Committee will conduct judging. Entries will be judged on creativity, effective communication, quality of execution and compliance with contest rules.

The Winners – Winners will be notified by March 4, 2022. Only the winners will be notified.

#### **Video Specifications**

- Be Creative
- No longer than 45 seconds in length
- Each team is encouraged to include their local water and/or wastewater utility in their video if possible.
- End with the Michigan Rural Water Association logo found at <a href="https://www.mrwa.net">www.mrwa.net</a>. (The logo must fit within the 45 second time limit).
- Be submitted with a completed application entry form and consent forms.
- If submitting a USB drive, please make video in a format we can play on any type of device.

### Submitting Your up to 45 Second Video

- Each entry must be reviewed and approved by a teacher representing the school that, if the entry is judged as a winner, will receive the \$1,500 award.
- Make a copy of the video. Once the video is submitted it is the property of MRWA.
